### Notice to Policyholders: How We Protect Your Privacy

This notice informs you, our valued policyholder, how we, The Mt. Morris Insurance Company, collect, disclose, and protect your nonpublic personal financial information. This notice also is given on behalf of other members of The Mt. Morris Mutual Insurance Company, including our Insurance Agents.

### Collecting Information to Conduct Our Business

We collect, retain, and use nonpublic personal financial information about you for the purpose of serving your insurance needs and adjusting our customer relationships. We may collect information about you from the following sources:

- Information we receive from you on applications, endorsements, or other forms, legal documents, or in response to oral requests for information from you (such as your assets and your income, and identifying information such as your name and address);
- Information about your transactions with us or others (such as policies purchased and premium payment history); and
- Information we receive from a consumer-reporting agency (such as your credit worthiness and credit history).

### To Whom We May Disclose That Information

**We do not disclose nonpublic personal financial information about customers or former customers to affiliated and nonaffiliated third parties except as permitted by law.**

### How We Protect the Confidentiality and Security of Your Nonpublic Personal Financial Information

We restrict access to nonpublic personal financial information about you to those employees who need to know that information to provide products or services to you. We maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with applicable federal regulations to guard your nonpublic personal financial information.
